## Quality Improvement Project Overview

### Overview

The Society of Infectious Disease Pharmacists (SIDP) offers a year-long antimicrobial stewardship certificate training program whose mission is to ADVANCE infectious diseases pharmacy through collaboration, research, and education LEAD antimicrobial stewardship to OPTIMIZE the care of patients with infections in every practice setting. Through Flex program funding from the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services, 25 pharmacists from Iowa critical access hospitals (CAHs) were given the opportunity to complete this rigorous training program that included implementation of a quality improvement (QI) project within their hospital.
